- 4. The applicant must complete the application
- 5. The applicant must have two letters of recommendation. One must be from a member of the Scottish American Society of Central Florida and one must be from a teacher or quidance counselor at the applicants high school.
- 6. The applicant must have volunteered for at least ten (10) hours for the Scottish American Society of Central Florida or at a society sponsored event such as the Scottish Highland Games and Festival held for two weekend days each January.
- 7. The applicant must submit a one thousand (1000) word essay about the values and rewards of volunteer service in today's society.
- 8. The applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher in high school.
